NFCB call to action

- The National Federation of Community Broadcasters sent a call to action for public/community radio

 - NFCB encourages people to write letters of support for public/community radio/KBOO to their congress people and senators to be sent before Friday, 5/2
 - Jill will host a letter writing party on Saturday, 4/26 from 10am until 1pm

All Thrills No Frills campaign

- This special programming campaign began in February and concludes after Earth Day programming in April
- Special programming included
 - Black History and Future month
 - Mardi Gras with the Roots of Rock and Roll
 - International Women's Day
 - Metal Marathon
 - Bluegrass Marathon
 - Comics Take
 - Earth Day
- Focus on fundraising happened through special programming rather than program hosts pitching on the air for the duration of the campaign.
- Goal:
 - \$40K total goal
 - \$5K merchandise
 - \$35K white mail and online goal

Grants

- Oregon Community Foundation
 - Requested \$21,500 through their Rural Arts and Culture program
 - Awarded \$41,500
 - **\$21,500 1st year**
 - \$10,000 2nd year
 - \$10,000 3rd year
- Jackson Foundation
 - Awarded \$5000 for news programming
- Marie Lamfrom Foundation
 - Requested \$30,000 for general opertations
 - Awarded \$24,000
- Spirit Mountain award
 - \$5000 for archiving
- Oregon Wildlife Federation
 - Awarded \$7,700 for general operations
