Governance committee meeting

Attendees: Zale Chadwick, Grace, Michael Papadopolis, Don, Ani, Jeff Kipilman, Sue Bartlett

First issue: exploring various ways of doing remote meeting participation.

Michael presented the example of Purdue. They have an extensive process defined on-line.

One best practice Michael suggested: everyone used the microphone when speaking and identified themselves, whether they were on Skype or at the main meeting. That way only one person speaks at a time and can be heard.

Issue: couldn't hear all the people.

Noted: most problems with remote participation can be resolved by process.

There are free phone conference software available. People with long distance would have to call in.

Facetime was suggested but it seems to be a 1:1 thing and only for Mac.

Everyone was asked to bring more meeting conference app ideas.

The committee elected Jeff as the board liaison.

Sue presented her idea about solving the issue of people who wanted to join meetings, but they were continually being cancelled.

Motion to go to the board:

All Other Committees and Standing Other Committees (as defined in By-law article VIII sections 3 and 4) of the board should meet monthly, at a regularly scheduled time. Meeting times will be posted in KBOO's lobby, and on website.

If the meeting is rescheduled or canceled, notice of such change will be posted a minimum of 72 hours in advance of either the regularly scheduled or the rescheduled meeting date, whichever comes first.

If a committee has frequently canceled or rescheduled meetings, the board should investigate that situation.
